

Today, mathematics occupies more and more space in our daily lives, but fewer and fewer young French men and women have a taste for math and engage in scientific studies.

Our future will be more and more dependent on mathematics and computer science. It is fundamental to offer access to the richness of all this knowledge, to give each and everyone the means to understand our world.

Present situation :

- **15,000 unfilled positions** in the digital sector (2019)
- **France, second to last in the PISA ranking** for the math level of 15-year-olds (2020)

The Maison Poincaré's museology is composed of innovative educational displays designed to highlight the diverse environments in which the discipline flourishes and how they relate to daily life.

- A project supported by the Institut Henri Poincaré
- 4 years of work
- End of work in the building in the last quarter of 2022
- 2000 m² of extension within the former laboratory of Jean Perrin
- 1100 m² of space dedicated to research
- 900 m² of permanent and temporary exhibitions

The Endowment Fund was started in 2016 to support - through private funds - projects such as the Maison Poincaré, an institution where science and society interact.
